"Personalised medicine in the health system: How to ensure sustainability and an effective collaboration between all health care players as well as with prevention services?"

Leading questions:

- 1. What institutional design is required to successfully meet the expectations put by the Personalised Medicine paradigm?
- 2. What needs to be considered at the patient/population level?
- 3. How to translate scientific knowledge into Patient-Targeted Interventions?



Recommendations:

- Promote the creation of PM Roadmaps and action plans and National and/or regional levels with clear objectives, including the development of a strong research agenda focused on the generation of scientific evidence.
- Create and disseminate a set of criteria that define what a PM preventive or therapy intervention is create a portfolio of successful cases of PM interventions and share it with policy makers and the public.
- Generate policy materials (i.e, white papers) to support the development of legislative and regulatory changes with the cooperation of ICPerMed members.
- Create a integrated pipeline adapted to the National and/or regional societal reality where specific roles for different stakeholders are clearly identified. A pipeline based on the empowerment of the patient community, and effective participation of stakeholders, including industry and developers.



Recommendations:

- Cocreate with the patient comunity and the public specific actions for adopting PM interventions (i.e PM-adapted informed consents).
- Develop, based on a cocreation process, a framework for assessing the efficiency of outcomes
 of PM interventions based on high quality electronic data.
- Generate standards and guideliness for large European population studies that will produce data that will be used for PM interventions.
- Develop specific training programs on PM for the health care workforce.
- Promote the creation, under the umbrella of ICPerMed, of a forum of policy makers from the health care domain to share experiences and suggest common actions.



Recommendations:

- Promote actions to integrate the research community into the health care community.
- Funders must support independent clinical trials to promote the adoption of PM solutions.
- Funders must support HTA evaluations studies including research on harmonization on existing HTA frameworks for PM interventions.
- Identify specific interventions at the population level to promote preventive personalized care.
- To create and reinforce cooperation with international organizations for developing an standarization framework for PM interventions.
