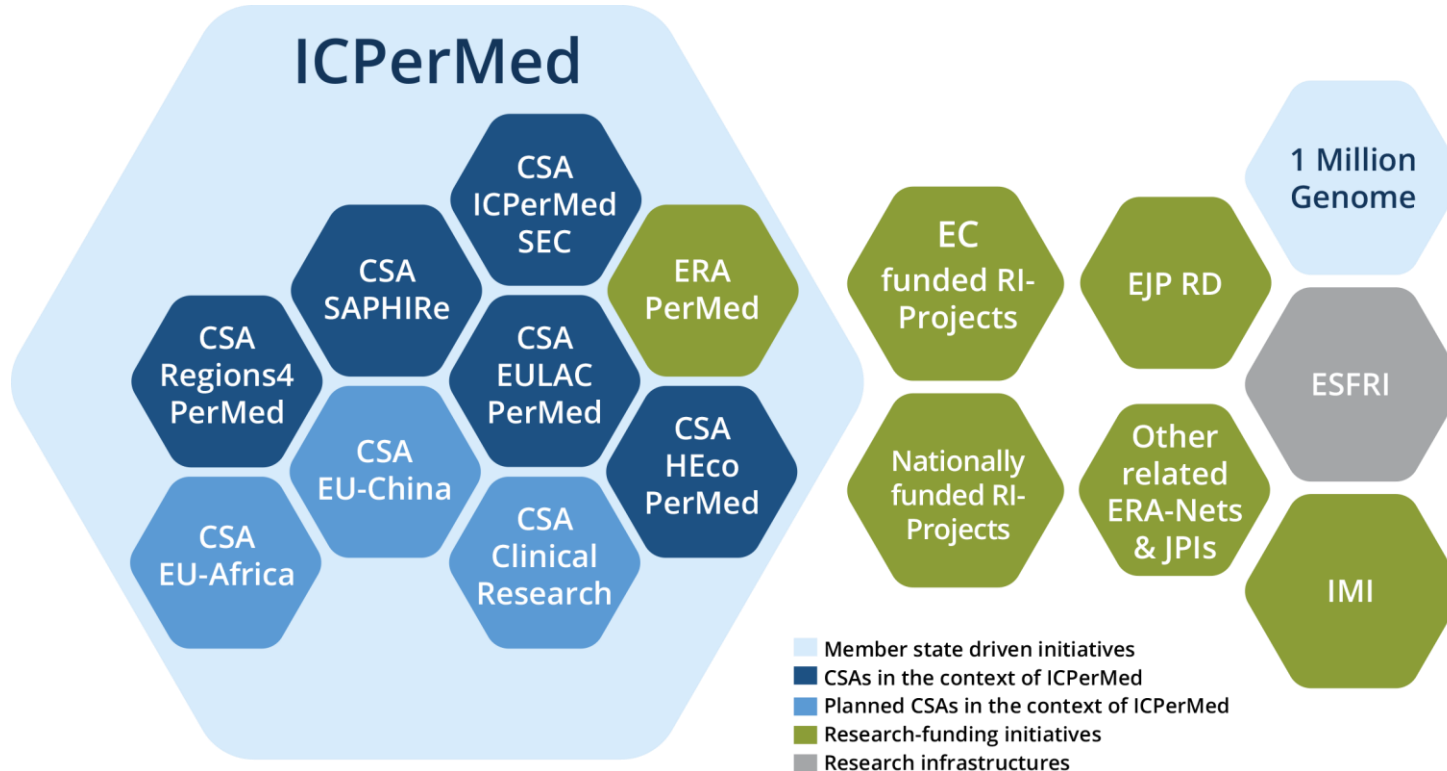
- More than 40 European and international partners

Aim: To coordinate and foster **research** to develop and evaluate personalised medicine approaches

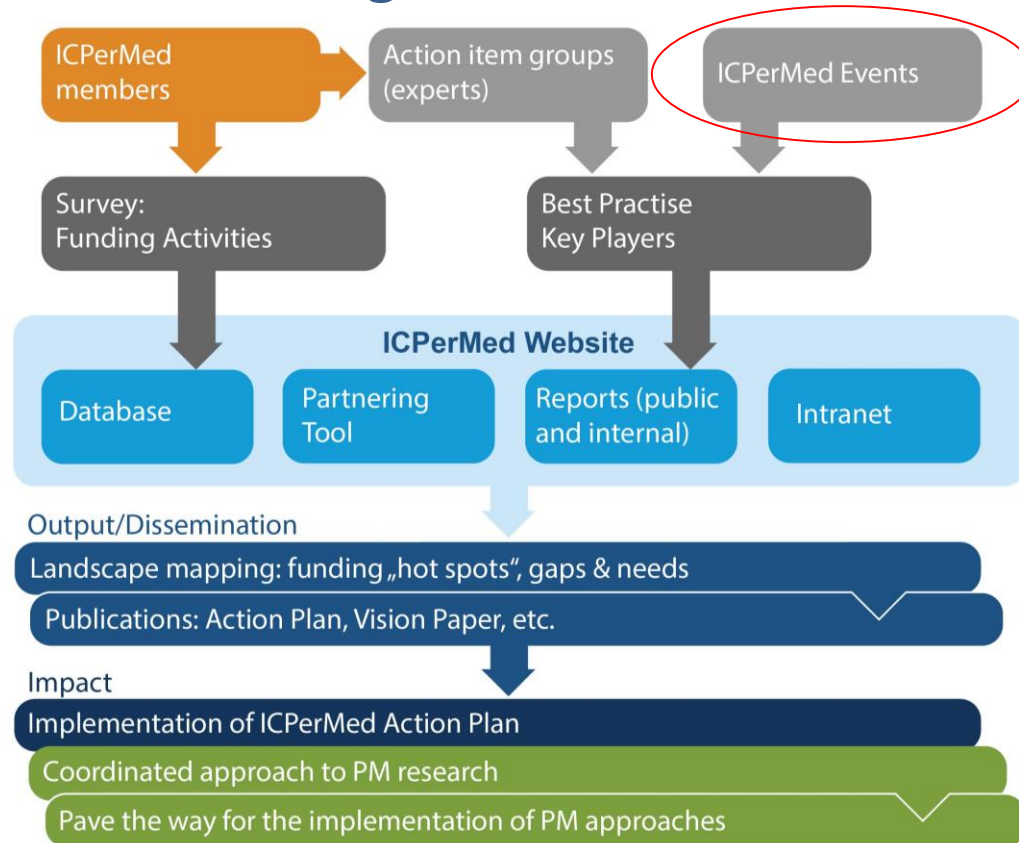
ICPerMed Vision Statement:
