ICPerMed Vision Statement:


- Establish **Europe** as a **global** leader in personalised medicine research.

- 2) Development of a common work programme



One of the aims of ICPerMed:

Follow up on the implementation of the Action Plan

To do: Identification of activities in the field of PM

Idea: To set up an inventory of regional, national, European and international

activities in PM

- Why? I. Increase the knowledge base for funders and stakeholders in PM research.
 - II. Avoid duplication of efforts but allow efficient use of already existing infrastructures/platforms.

Internal Reporting

1) Reporting by ICPerMed members

How?

ICPerMed members agreed by sending their Letter of Interest to share results, data and information about activities in PM in their country and/or region

Means: Surveys, internal reporting

Communication of outcomes of mapping activities:

- development of research policies, strategies and guidelines;
- ICPerMed reports, e.g. the State of the Art Reports¹;
- the ICPerMed mapping database.







To do: Identification of activities in the field of PM

Different ongoing internal mapping activities:

- → What is going on in the field of Personalised Medicine?
- → Identification of **funding activities in PM** (on the programme level).
- → Identification of **other activities in PM** (initiatives, platforms, infrastructures, etc.)
- → Identification of example of good practice.
- → Identification of baseline activities in PM or current status.
- → Identification of key players/stakeholders.












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


Program coverage






Program coverage / funding dedicated to PM






Program – Type of research supported









The database reflects the progress of the ICPerMed consortium towards the objectives and implementation of the ICPerMed Action Plan.








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












Research Supporting Activities
